

Let us give thanks to the Lord

We thank thee, Lord, For fields of grain Gold and ripe from summer's rain, For hillsides bright with scarlet trees That rustle in the autumn breeze, For friend so dear, For those we love, For all things sent from heaven above... We thank thee, Lord.



Monday, we celebrate Thanksgiving and we offer the Mass and our prayers this weekend for the many graces that God has given us.

However, I am very aware that today we may struggle to find something to be thankful for. There may be someone who have or are still suffering physically. As well that there are many who are suffering with mental illness and especially the silent scourges of anxiety and depression. For some there has been economic or family stress. Please know that you are all in my thoughts and prayers. As always, if you need someone to talk to please feel free to contact me.

But, I may suggest that giving thanks is more important than ever. In times of difficulty it is a temptation to be cynical and to question God. Yet when we give thanks we look at the completeness of our life and it makes us realize that indeed there is goodness in it and that God is still with us and has never abandoned us and with His grace these dark times will pass.

I might use an extreme example to illustrate this point: In the Agony of the Garden and the passion of our Lord Jesus Christ, in those moments of the cross, there were also moments of quite comfort. The angel that comforts Jesus in the garden of Gethsemane. During the passion, there was St. Veronica who wipes Jesus' face, the centurion who gave Him something to drink when Jesus said "I thirst", by pious custom we attribute this to St. Longinus and Mary, St. John, St. Mary Magdalene and the other woman who stayed with Him at the foot of the cross. But you know, the cross is not the end of Jesus' story. That is the resurrection. It was Him coming back to his disciples and continuing a life in the Church with them. Even telling St. Peter at the last Supper that "I have prayed for you that your faith may not fail and when you have turned again strengthen your brethren" (Lk 22:32) Jesus is looking past St. Peter's weakness at the passion, in fact He is looking past the passion itself to the joy and glory of the resurrection. Giving thanks not only reminds us that God has never abandoned us, but more so, it gives us hope, hope that this moment will pass and that joy will return until we experience that fullness of Joy when He comes again.

I may not know how your Thanksgiving will look like this year. Truth be told at the time I write this note I'm not fully sure where I will be spending it. Regardless, I pray that you do find happiness in it and that we will be able to give thanks to God for the graces He has given us this year, as we look with great hope to the days that follow. May you all have a happy and blessed Thanksgiving.
