


Father, You revealed Your Son to the nations by the guidance of a star. Lead us to Your Glory in Heaven by the Light of Faith.

#### IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING COVID 19 PROTOCOLS

Due to the potential risk of the Omicron Variant of Covid 19, we need to continue the Covid Protocols for the New Year.

A reminder capacity limit in the Church is 125 people.

#### These protocols will be strictly enforced:

- 1. We will be entering and exiting from the main doors, a reminder masks must be worn.
- 2. As you enter the Church your hands will be sanitized.
- 3. In order to celebrate with us, you must ensure that your mask is properly worn at all times, covering your nose and mouth.


