
# St. Bernard de Clairvaux Church

#### IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING COVID 19 PROTOCOLS

Due to the potential risk of the Omicron Variant of Covid 19, we need to continue the Covid Protocols for the New Year.

A reminder capacity limit in the Church is 125 people.

#### These protocols will be strictly enforced:

- 1. We will be entering and exiting from the main doors, a reminder masks must be worn.
- 2. As you enter the Church your hands will be sanitized.
- 3. In order to celebrate with us, you must ensure that your mask is properly worn at all times, covering your nose and mouth.
- 4. It is important that we continue to practice social distancing.
- 5. We ask you to continue the normal safety protocols when in the Church: namely; that we come up for Communion one row at a time and that if you are feeling ill, especially if you are coughing, that you refrain from celebrating in person.
