
# St. Bernard de Clairvaux Church

#### **Covid19 Restrictions**

As you know the pandemic is slowly winding down and like many institutions we can now take the next steps in moving back to a more normal situation. We remind everyone that Churches are as safe as any where else that you may go.

As such, there are no longer any mandatory use of masks at any point during the celebration of Mass., nor is hand sanitation required. For those who feel comfortable they may return to offering their hand at the sign of peace. The ushers will no longer be offering spray sanitizer at the entrance of the Church, but we will still have sanitizers at the back for those who wish to use it.

However, we would ask that in charity we would respect peoples' sensitivity in these matters. If anyone wishes to still wear a mask, they are more than welcome to do so and we also ask your understanding, should people beside you still wish to bow at the sign of peace. We understand that everyone will adapt to these measures at their own pace.

#### HUMANITARIAN RELIEF - PAKISTAN FLOODS

Devastating floods in Pakistan have displaced hundreds of thousands, at one point leaving a third of the country inundated with water. More than 1,500 people have died following record rainfall with 33 million throughout the country affected by this disaster.

There is an elevated risk of the spread of malaria, dengue fever and other diseases. Priorities include clean water, shelter and health care for those directly affected by this tragic situation.
