New Liturgical Practise for Lent

To keep the solemnity of Lent this year, we will pray the Nicene Creed instead of the Apostles Creed during the Mass. In doing so we will be in union with our brothers and sisters throughout the world and even in own Parish, who normally pray the Nicene Creed. "This is the Creed we pray at the Italian and Malayaam Masses every Sunday." You can find the Nicene Creed in your missalettes, in the inside front cover of the "Gather Hymnals" or printed below:

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven of earth, of all things visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, The Only Begotten Son of God, Born of the Father before all ages.

God from God, Light from Light, True God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; Through him all things were made.

For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven,

All bow at the following words up to and including: and became man.

and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.

I believe in one, holy catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgivness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.
