



Have you noticed that there is less commercials about Easter eggs and rabbits than before? They made me smile as it reminded me that a more joyous time was soon upon us. Sadly, I suppose as people abandon religion the trappings and tradition of religion also fade away.

Now, I don't want to be accused of Leporiphobia (the fear or aversion to rabbits-apparently that is a thing) but we know that rabbits is not what Easter is about and that it comes from pre-Christian celebrations of spring. Easter is of course the main celebration of the Christian Faith. Jesus rose from the dead. Our redemption was wrought on the cross when Jesus saved us from our sins opened for us the gates of Heaven and made union with Him possible which, as the source of all love, becomes the center of our life.

Say to people when they ask, what did you do this weekend. "I was at Mass it was great." Let us joyfully celebrate Easter, however we want, but celebrate the greatest Solemnity of the year because Jesus has been raised from the dead. Say a prayer to Him before we eat. Think of Him when we decorate our homes. Something as simple as having flowers near a crucifix or picture of the Lord. It's not a family day to just have a family day. My mom put it best: "if you need a holiday to see me then something is wrong."

A Christian need not be dour or sad all the time, Joy is a fruit of the faith after all. But the faithful should be you know... faithful. Our world changed for the better when Christ came and I am not ashamed or afraid to say so. I also mercifully do not suffer with Leporiphobia, so after Mass I will very much be looking forward to a rendezvous with a chocolate rabbit!

Wherever this Easter finds you I sincerely hope that all the blessing and joy of the risen Lord be with you and all your loved ones.
