
When we go to a family reunion or a wedding or any event. Do we want to be recognized by your hosts? To have them say "I'm glad you are here, we're honoured you came." Or is it better just to be a nameless face in a sea of faces?

Of course to Jesus we are very important. He calls us by name. Knows us intimately. God the Father uses the image that He has "carved our name in the palm of His hand" (Is 49:16) and Jesus says that even the number of hairs on our head is known. (Lk 12:7) Now you don't get more important than that to anyone

How does Jesus treat those who are important to Him. How did He treat His Apostles? Well. He says "I do not call you servants any longer for the servant does not know what the master is doing but I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you (Jn: 15:15) In a sense He lets them into His life and gave them a share in it, in His mission to help found and build His Church.

We know of Mary's calling to be Jesus' mother and our own, mediatrix of all graces. Of St. Peter our first pope and the Apostles our first bishops. We've all heard of St., Francis and St. Therese. How about Sts. Pricilla and Aquila, a married couple friends of St. Paul so important in Rome or St. Silas or St. Phoebe? They also had their role to play as well. And so do we. Big or small we too are given a share in Christ's mission for ourselves. There are the great missions of priesthood religious life that I know some of you are being called to. As well as Holy Marriage and to raise up children for God, if it be His will. But what of being a member of the choir, alter server, catechist for children. Helping the poor in St. Vincent de Paul. Of being an evangelist, speaking of the faith and encouraging it's sacraments and Holy practices.

The Holy Spirit like at Pentecost, gives to each a share of works or charisms and the graces to accompany them so that they may succeed. A quick story, a person worked a long time ago as a labourer. He mixed mortar that was used to bind the stones of a great Cathedral being built. He worked on it for years and years. When the Cathedral was finished, he went to the Mass of Consecration. When it was over the Bishop found him and thanked him so much for all he had done. 'Excellency" he replied "all I did was mix mortar nor was I the only one to do so" "Yes he said, and without your work to make that mortar not one stone would be standing on another." Now at this point I ought to ask what is your charism? But I won't. A charism is an identity given to us not something we choose. As my spiritual director said "If you were going to do it anyway it's not a charism." Rather, pray, pray to the Holy Spirit and ask Him, what is my place in God's plan? What would you have me do?

Last week, our collection was **\$2,331.00** It takes \$5,000.00 to cover weekly expenses. Thank you to those who support us. Your charity means a lot!






