Wishing you a blessed third Sunday of Advent!!!

Traditionally, the third week of Advent is called Gaudate Sunday, the Sunday of Joy.

On Gaudate Sunday, the season of Advent shifts its focus. For the first two weeks of Advent, the focus can be summed up in the phrase, "*The Lord is coming*". But beginning with Gaudete Sunday, the summary might be, "*The Lord is near*". This shift is marked by a lighter mood and a heightened sense of joyous anticipation. In the Church we begin to see Christmas decorations.

Liturgically, the colours lighten as well. The priest usually wears rose-coloured vestments, a hue seen only on Gaudete Sunday and Laetare Sunday. On this day, we light the third candle of the Advent wreath, which is also rose-coloured.

The word "Gaudete" is Latin for "Rejoice." This celebration is a reminder that God who loves us is still in charge and that we await His coming not with fear but with tremendous joy.

St. Paul in His letter to the Ephesians, reflects this joy: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I will say, Rejoice. Let all know your forbearance. The Lord is at hand. Have no anxiety about anything but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which passes all understanding, will keep your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

### Update Regarding the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund

On December 12, 2023 the Archdiocese of Toronto announced the first phase of funding as part of our \$6 million commitment to the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund (IRF). Through the tremendous generosity of parishioners throughout the archdiocese, including our own parish, more than \$2.7 million has been directed through the IRF to organizations and projects committed to promoting healing and reconciliation for communities and families.

Recipients include **Wigwamen Terrace** located in Toronto, Ontario that will receive \$475,000 over five years allowing the organization to hire additional support staff in order to provide their elderly residents with assistance with navigating technology, accessing mental health services and maintaining connections to Indigenous cultural and spiritual communities and resources.
