

MASS MINUTES -- WEEK 5

There are several important liturgical objects that draw one's attention when entering a Church and each has its own significance. In most Churches, the nearest of these objects to the entrance is the Holy Water Font into which the faithful each dip a finger and make the Sign of the Cross. Making the Sign of the Cross with holy water before Mass is a reminder of the Sacrament of Baptism. In Baptism, through water and the invocation of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit people become membrs of the Church. Only once a person has been baptized can they participate in the Sacrifice of the Mass and receive Holy Communion as one truly in communion with Christ and the Church. So it is particularly appropriate to recall and renew one's Baptism before Mass. The next act one should perform on entering a Church is genuflecting towards the Tabernacle where Christ, present in the Holy Eucharist is reserved. genuflection towards Christ in the Eucharist expresses worship and obedience to Christ our God and King of kings. The traditional practice of placing the Tabernacle centrally in the Sanctuary reflects the arrangements of royal courts where the king sits in the central place and his subjects approach him and pay him homage. The genuflection towards the Tabernacle emphasizes the truth that Christ is our ultimate ruler to whom we owe complete service. Furthermore, it reminds us that the liturgical act that we are about to perform, the Sacrifice of the Mass, takes place before the throne of God, the Father Himself, in whose service God the Son came to perform His work of Redemption. A lit red candle near the Tabernacle indicates that it does in fact contain the Eucharist. If the candle is not lit and the door of the Tabernacle is open, then the Tabernacle is empty and one should not genuflect towards The Holy Water and the Tabernacle are signs that remind the faithful that they enter the Church as members of the Church come to worshop their God and King.

When Blessing yourself with Holy Water, here is a good prayer, "During the Mass Father may You be in my mind that I may know You, Jesus in my heart that I may love You and Holy Spirit be on my shoulders to support me. Amen"
