MASS MINUTES -- WEEK 10 The Chasuble

The Chasuble is the outer garment that the priest wears. It represents the attitude that we bring to each Mass.

WHITE: Represents purity of heart used for celebrating those of pure soul, Christmas, Easter, other solemnities of Christ, Mary and the Saints.

GREEN: Most common Sunday colour, symbolizes hope.

PURPLE/VIOLET: A subdued colour for sorrow and penance. Used during Advent and Lent, during which we are purifying ourselves for the Churches biggest feast.

Red: Symbolizes fire. Used for Mass of the Holy Spirit because He descended like tongues of fire upon the heads of the Apostles. Also, it is the symbol of blood and is used to celebrate the Martyrs who shed blood for Christ.

Less used colours:

Rose: Symbolizes subdued joy. Advent and Lent are almost over and we anticipate Christmas and Easter.

Black: Symbolizes mystery, we pray for those who have died.

Gold: Symbolizes TRIUMPH!

Interesting Fact: Slowly Blue is being introduced for Memorial Masses for Mary, a colour associated with Her by tradition.
