

MASS MINUTES - WEEK 16 OFFERINGS AND THE SACRED VESSELS

The Church has some established norms for the composition of the vessels (such as the Chalice) and the bread and wine offerings to be used during the Mass. The requirements arise both from the sacredness of the offerings and the need to ensure the validity of the Mass. A Chalice must be made from precious metal, such as gold or silver. Other precious materials can be used so long as the inside cup portion of the Chalice is covered with gold. This is done primarily because of the sacredness of He who will be contained therein but also to remind us that we reserve for God the best gifts we have as Abel did. The same regulations hold for the other sacred vessels in the Liturgy that contain the Body and Blood of Christ. A ciborium is what we call the vessel that holds the hosts that will be distributed during Communion.

Before the Mass, the Chalice is set with several items for use in the Liturgy. A white piece of linen cloth with a small red crucifix in the middle, called a Purificator, is placed folded over the Chalice. The priest uses the Purificator to wipe the Chalice and other sacred vessels after the distribution of Holy Communion, to ensure that no particles of the Body and Blood of Christ are simply left to go stale or bad in the vessels and to ensure due reverence is given to them. The Purificator does sometimes come in contact with the Eucharist, so it is washed in a special way that ensures no particle of the Body and Blood of Christ ends up in the sewer. The patten is placed on top of the purificator on the Chalice.

The patten is a sacred vessel because it contains the host that the priest holds during the consecration. Above the host and patten is placed the pall. The pall is a thin stiff piece of board that functions doubly as structural support to the articles placed above it and as a means for keeping things such as dust or insects from getting into the Chalice during parts of the Mass when the patten is not over the Chalice.

The Chalice veil goes over the pall covering the whole The colour of the veil matches the Chalice beneath it. colour of the Chasibule at Mass. By adding to the visual beauty of the Mass, the veil contributes to spirit of reverence and worship. Above the veil is the burse, which consists of two thin stiff pieces of board encased with cloth coloured to the liturgical season. The primary purpose of the burse is to contain the corporal. The corporal is a piece of linen cloth with a small red cross on it. During the Offertory, the corporal is unfolded and on the altar and all the sacred vessels are placed upon it. It is the intention of the priest only to consecrate the bread and wine that are placed on the corporal. The word corporal means body for the Body of Christ will rest on it. The divesting of the Chalice of the veil that takes place during the Offertory symbolizes the stripping of Christ of His garments in preparation for His crucifixion.

If your child is 12 years old or over and not baptized, but would like to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion and Confirmation you must attend this meeting.
