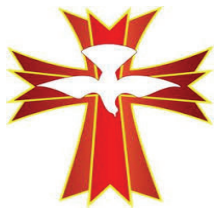
First Holy Communion 2025

The First Holy Communion Registration will be held on Tuesday, October 8th, 2024 at 7:00 pm in the Church.

Please bring the following:

- 1) The completed registration form with a copy of your child's baptismal certificate.
- 2) \$20.00 to cover cost of the book to be used at the Catechesis classes. The book will be given to you at the registration meeting.

For those who do not attend St. Bernard's School (which will be given a form from the school by mid-September) or if your child is 7 years old or over and not baptized, but would like to receive the Sacrament of Confession and Holy Communion, please come to the office and pick up a Registration Form. You must come to this meeting as well, with the completed registration form.



CONFIRMATION 2025

Confirmation Registration will be held on Tuesday, October 15th, 2024 at 7:00 pm in the Church.

Please bring the following with you:

- 1) The completed registration form with a copy of your child's baptismal certificate.
- 2) A fee of \$50.00 to cover the cost of materials to be used at the Catechesis classes. Information will be given to you at the registration meeting.

For those who do not attend St. Bernard's School (you will be given a form from the school by mid-September) but belong to our parish we are most happy to celebrate the sacrament with you. Please come and pick up a Registration Form in the office.

If your child is 12 years old or over and not baptized, but would like to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion and Confirmation you must attend this meeting.

LIVER DONOR

Dear friends

I'm writing to you to let you know my sister Elena Gregory has liver disease. Over time, the liver disease has gotten worse causing her liver to not work well enough to keep her alive.

A liver transplant will save Elena's life. She is 63 years old, has a husband, son and two grandchildren. She has lived a clean, healthy life and unfortunately has been dealt with this disease.

She has been on a donor list for a year and a half. Family members and friends have been tested but unfortunately were not a suitable match.

To be a donor for Elena your blood type must be O Positive or O Negative and usual donors are 16 – 60 years of age.
