#### MASS MINUTES - WEEK 22 THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

All Baptized Catholics in communion with the Church and in the state of grace may receive and in accordance with the Church Law (Code of Cannon Law 912-923) have the right to receive Holy Communion. A Baptized Catholic is in union with the Church when they believe and confess all that the Church believes and teaches. And they are a living member of the Church when they are in the state of grace. To be in the state of grace is to possess the sacramental life of God in one's soul. This state is first achieved by Baptism but may be lost through mortal sin. Mortal sin is by definition a sin that kills the life of grace in the soul and separates the soul from God. The action of mortal sin involves the knowing and deliberate rejection of God and His law in a serious matter such that the individual rejects God as their maker and ruler of their life and as their saviour. Serious violations of the Ten Commandments and the Precepts of the Church all constitute mortal sins. One who has committed a mortal sin must receive forgiveness for that sin and make peace with God through the Sacrament of Confession.

The faithful are also required out of reverence for the Eucharist to abstain for an hour from eating before receiving Holy Communion. When receiving Holy Communion, one should make a gesture of reverence before Some recommended signs of reverence are receiving. genuflecting, bowing or kneeling to receive. The priest will raise the Eucharist up before each person who approaches for Holy Communion and say the words: "The Body of To this, the communicant replies, "Amen," Christ." expressing their assent to the truth that Christ is truly present in the Eucharist and that they are in communion with the faith of the Church. One may receive Holy Communion either on the tongue or in the hand. One who chooses to receive Holy Communion by hand should form his hands into the shape of a throne for the Lord who is about to be placed upon them and very carefully place the Body of Christ in their mouth so as to prevent even the smallest particle from falling (St. Cyril of Jerusalem Mystagogical Catechesis 23,22).

This is a worldwide collection for the missionary church and it is our opportunity to assist at-need Catholic Communities globally.
