About a month ago an elderly lady who started coming to our parish asked me for a request “Father, I must be getting a little hard of hearing, but I can’t hear what you say half the time can you talk a little louder please?” Last week a parishioner who sits in the front pew said he missed some words I said and wondered if he needed to have his hearing checked.

Truth is their hearing is probably just fine. Our Sound system is terrible.

It was not the highest quality to begin with, and the wiring was not done correctly. I know that the decision to go on with this route was made to save money. Sound systems are notoriously and shockingly expensive. But we got what we paid for: We did not pay much, and we did not get much. Worse still our sound system is old and is beginning to fail. Patching it up, which we have tried, is obviously not working to be perfectly honest. It is just going to get much worse to the point that at some point it won’t be worth turning on a microphone.

Now I understand the desire to live within our means. I have tried not asking you for money. I know that for some of our parishioners making ends meet is a struggle. I thank those who donate to our parish, and I try to save up the money until we can address an issue. If you ever thought, “Hmm this or that in the parish looks run down, why isn’t someone looking after that.” It’s because I do not want to burden anyone.

However, there is no way we can ever hope to save enough to replace the entire sound system. As I said they are notoriously expensive. But if you are going to spend a lot of money, best to do it right so that we do not have to be disappointed we still can’t hear well or have to upgrade it a few years after we put it in.

The finance committee, along with one of the choir directors and myself, have spoken to G.H Grassby & Associates, a leading sound engineering company. They have worked with other churches, concert halls and other large venues. If you ever want to hear their work for yourself, go to St. Philip Neri, our neighboring Parish on Jane St. They just installed a new sound system there. They came in and looked at St. Bernard’s Church and our sound system. Replacing it will cost roughly \$100,000 (\$102,281.25 for the sake of transparency)

I’ll give you a moment for the sticker shock to hit you. I know I needed a moment.

What this practically means is that we are asking for \$200 per adult. It can be given half now and half in December or January. We can do half of the project at one time, and we will see noticeable improvement and then we can reach our goal of a clear sound in the second phase. (Of course, the more we get the more we can do.)

Not to be forceful but if there are those not committed to this, half measures will result in half measures and that is not fair to all of you who deserve to hear and be able to participate at Mass. I will do my part. I need your help though.

There are renovation envelopes in the back of the Church. You may place your donation inside and put the envelopes into the regular collection. It’s never easy to ask for money. (I, actually hate doing it) so if you have read this with an open mind and heart, thank-you.

- 2) A fee of \$50.00 to cover the cost of materials to be used at the Catechesis classes. Information will be given to you at the registration meeting.

For those who do not attend St. Bernard’s School but belong to our parish we are most happy to celebrate the sacrament with you. Please come and pick up a registration form in the office.

If your child is 12 years old or over and not baptized, but would like to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion and Confirmation you must attend this meeting.

CHANGES TO WEEKDAY MASSES

The Tuesday and Thursday weekday Masses, moving forward, will be bi-lingual, English and Italian. They will continue to be at 8:00 A..M.

This change takes effect in October.

This change was made in consultation recognizing that the number of Italians speaking parishioners have fallen to an unsustainable number for some time. As our parish continues to change we hope that we can be open to the needs of our community and we hope that more people will avail themselves of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and daily communion, which brings with it many graces for the day.
